

Håvard Hjulstad is currently working as project manager at Standards Norway, working with projects within terminology, ICT and service standardization, in particular from the point of view of multilingualism and cultural diversity. The projects are national, European, and international, including:

- Secretary if CEN/ISSS Cultural Diversity Focus Group (CDFG), which addresses cultural diversity issues of European ICT standardization;
- Chair of the ISO/TC 207 Terminology Coordination Group (TCG), which coordinates the terminology used in the ISO 14000 series of International Standards for environmental management;
- Chair of ISO/TC 37 since 1998;
- Member of the ISO/TMB ad hoc group “Standards as databases”, developing entirely new procedures for developing and publishing certain International Standards (including terminology standards);
- The development of the terminology activities at Standards Norway.

From 1982 he worked at the Norwegian Council for Technical Terminology (RTT) until it was closed down in 2001, from 1989 as director.

Håvard Hjulstad has been involved in a large number of terminology and general language dictionary projects. He has also provided, and is providing, terminology and language consultancy services on freelance basis.
