

Hanne Erdman Thomsen is an Associate Professor of computational linguistics at the Copenhagen Business School where she has been employed 1984-88 and again from 1992 to the present. She has been a member of ISO TC37/SC1 since 2004, and is currently the convenor of WG 3 – “Principles, methods and vocabulary” and a member of the TC37 task force “TC37 Terminology Harmonization”.

She has worked with terminological data, terminology databases, data modelling for lexicographic and terminological purposes, terminological concept modelling, terminological principles and formal semantics. Her research is focused on terminology, specifically formalization of terminology work. Her teaching focuses on the basics of terminology work, computational terminology (including terminology extraction) and the introduction of terminology work and terminology management systems in (business) organisations.
